Middle School Jamboree:

- 3-4 teams at each jamboree site (36 total offensive snaps from line of scrimmage)
 - 3 team sites 15 offensive snaps against each opponent
 - Home team Plays first against B, then B vs C and home vs C team
 - 4 team sites 10 offensive snaps against each opponent
 - Teams will play simultaneously: A vs B & C vs D on opposite ends of the field, after both teams have completed offensive snaps, teams rotate to another opponent.
- If first downs are not reached after 4 plays, offensive team restarts at the 40-yard line
- Punting, Field Goals, Extra-Points, Kick-off will not be used within Jamboree Style Play

Coaches/Referees:

- OSAA Sanctioned Referees are <u>not</u> mandatory for Jamboree style contests
- Coaching Staff:
 - <u>Idea</u>: would high school coaches, upperclassmen, etc. be willing or able to help officiate? What a great way for our HS programs to give back and build additional rapport within our youth programs.
 - At least one coach from each team will be present on the field throughout offense and defensive series (more coaches the better)
 - Coaches should have flags and whistle at all times
 - Students learn best through failure followed up with immediate feedback
 - Coaches from all schools should work together to provide the optimal learning experience for our student athletes.

Regular Scheduled Games SOP's:

- 1. The National Federation of State High School Associations rule book will be the official rule book. We will also follow the OSAA handbook for issues not addressed within our League SOP's
- 2. Fall sports practice will not begin prior to the Monday before Labor Day.
- 3. Game games will be on Wednesdays and begin at 5:30 pm or 6:00 pm depending on availability and lights. Schools must be flexible in working with one another based on availability and times.
- 4. Games will consist of 4 ten-minute quarters with a ten-minute halftime.
- 5. The maximum number of league games per grade level shall be seven (7)
- 6. No football games shall be played until 9 days of practice have been completed
- 7. OSAA Officials are required and the responsibility of the home school
- 8. Postponed games that can be rescheduled during the same week as the original schedule may be made up. However, if that is not possible the game should be canceled due to scheduling restrictions. As a general rule, teams should not play more than one game per week.
- 9. It is strongly recommended that all games have someone in attendance trained in first aid.
- 10. An intermediate size football shall be used.

- 11. The home team will wear dark colored jerseys while the visiting team will wear white or lightcolored jerseys. Exceptions will be made by mutual consent of the schools involved.
- 12. Neither team shall be allowed to communicate from a press box or other vantage point directly with their team. This includes electronic, verbal, written, or any other form of communication during the game.
- 13. Coaches shall make every effort to allow each individual of the team playing time that is appropriate.

Special Teams SOP's:

Special teams are a vital part of football, and we need to coach/mentor/teach our middle school student athletes these aspects within our programs. Though special teams will not be part of the Jamboree series, by the first scheduled game all coaches shall agree to implement special teams within their programs.

- 1. Kickoffs Follow HS kickoff, but regardless of outcome, the receiving team will place the ball on the 40-yard line.
- 2. Punts no rush and regardless of outcome receiving team will start with the ball 35 yards from the line of scrimmage
- 3. PAT's worth 2 points at middle school level
- 4. On-side Kicks NFHS Standard rules (Kick-off team must recover after 10 yards)

Scoring:

- 1. Touchdown 6 points
- 2. Extra Point (kicking) 2 points
- 3. Extra Point conversion (run or pass) 1 point
- 4. Field Goal 3 points
